- 9% equity holder, working in Bathurst Camp + 15 years

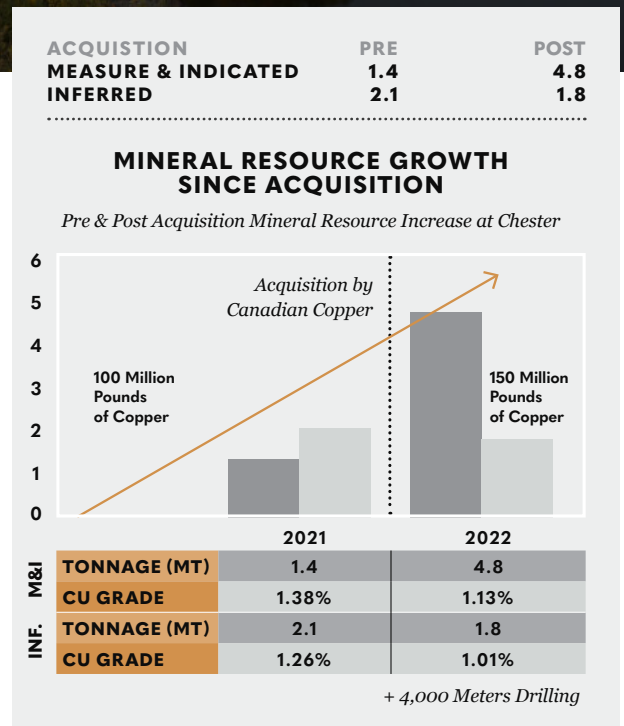
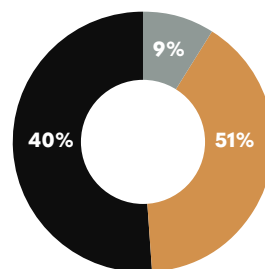
CHESTER 2022 DRILLING HIGHLIGHTS
